9:30-10:30	Your literacy lesson is Unit 13 Dog, Cat and Monkey . Read this through with an adult. Then answer the questions, where it says DAYS 4/5 in your book. You need to write a description of the fight between the dog and the cat. You need to think of yourself as the monkey who is hiding behind the tree and watching it all happen.
