



## Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2020

9:00-9:30	<p>This morning I would like an adult to test you on your <b>number club</b> and <b>spellings</b>.</p> <p>To move up to the next level you must get all of the sums correct, without any adult help, in 10 minutes. You should set a timer so this is accurate. Any spellings that you get wrong please copy out 3 times.</p> <p>*New maths sheets and spelling sheets for next week can be found on the Weobley school website. Use <b>spelling bee</b> sheets for your spellings starting at Bee 10.</p>
9:30-10:00	<p>Your literacy lesson is to use your plan from yesterday to rewrite the story of '<b>How the giraffe got its long neck</b>'.</p> <p>Yesterday you should have drawn 6 pictures to tell the events that happened in the story, so use those pictures to help you retell the story in your own words.</p> <p><b>Date</b> at the top of the page</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Write a <b>heading</b> and <b>underline</b> it</li><li>2. Use <b>adjectives</b> to make your story more interesting</li><li>3. <b>Adverbs</b>- words that describe how we do things...The giraffe <b>cautiously</b> put his head into the hole in the tree.</li><li>4. Don't forget to use <b>rainbow words</b> when you start a new picture to help link your story together.....eg...One day, after that, suddenly, finally etc</li><li>5. You must write about each picture you have drawn.</li></ol> <p>Once you have finished, get an adult to mark it for you. They should look at the points I have given here and give you a point for each one.</p> <p>There were 5 points to look for in your writing. How many points did you get?</p>

10:00-10:30	Don't forget to join us for <i>Golden Assembly</i> live from Weobley Primary School.
11:00-12:00	<p>Work Maths - Booklet Multiplication and division Pages 14,15 and 16</p> <p>Page 14 you will need to write the multiplication in a different way. Don't forget with multiplication you can swap the numbers around and you will still get the same answers.</p> <p>Page 15 and 16 is revising what we did yesterday on triangular numbers. So you could always watch the video again if you are not sure!</p> <p>If you have time and want to try the next 3 pages (17,18,19) then do.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Product means the answer</li> <li>2. Repeated addition is eg <math>3 \times 2 = 2+2+2</math></li> <li>3. Commutative property means turning it around. Eg <math>3 \times 2</math> is the same as <math>2 \times 3</math></li> <li>4. Array means pattern eg <math>2 \times 3</math> is <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>***</li> <li>***</li> </ul> </li> <li>5. Groups you must circle the groups eg <math>2 \times 3</math> means 2 circles with 3 in each.</li> </ol> <p>Hope that helps</p>
