Subject: Art and Design

National Curriculum Aims

The national curriculum for art and design aims to ensure that all pupils:

- (A1) produce creative work, exploring their ideas and recording their experiences
- (A2) become proficient in drawing, painting, sculpture and other art, craft and design techniques
- (A3) evaluate and analyse creative works using the language of art, craft and design
- (A4) now about great artists, craft makers and designers, and understand the historical and cultural development of their art forms.

Weobley Primary School Aims

- (WA1)To promote an appreciation of art and creative expression that lasts a lifetime.
- (WA2)Provide children with opportunities where learning and teaching are taken beyond the classroom and can involve the wider community; making purposeful links with craftspeople, artists and designers in Herefordshire.
- (WA3)Take part in local art initiatives e.g. Hereford College of Art
- (WA4)Develop children's individual spiritual, moral, social and cultural development through thought provoking creative activities.
- (WA5)Stimulate creative expression enabling children to share their ideas, thoughts and feelings in a variety of media.

National Curriculum Aims and Attainment Targets - KS1

Pupils should be taught:

- (AD1) to use a range of materials creatively to design and make products
- (AD2) to use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination
- (AD3) to develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space
- (AD4) about the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers, describing the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines, and making links to their own work.
